Ending Child Marraige Program in Maharashtra

SAKSHUM Ending Child Marriage: Training of Trainers (ToT) Workshop conducted by SBC3 in collaboration with UNICEF & Women and Child Department, Maharashtra.

SAKSHUM Ending Child Marriage: Training of Trainers (ToT) workshop is aimed at developing Master trainers for cascading the Prevention, Intervention, Coordination and Monitoring strategies for prevention of child marriages with ground-level Frontline workers. The training equipped the master trainers to understand the ill effects of child marriages, rights of children, child sexual abuse, gender stereotypes, methods of prevention of child marriages, child protection laws along PCMA 2006. It has provided the knowledge and skills to master trainers for cascading the training in their respective districts.

In October, SBC3 with the support of the Women and Child Department, State of Maharashtra & UNICEF conducted 4 SAKSHUM Ending Child Marriage: Training of Trainers workshops wherein Master Trainers from Anganwadi Supervisor - Integrated Child Development Department, ANM, LHV, TNO, BNO - Health Department, Extension Officer - Panchayat Department, Extension Officer - Education Department, Protection Officer and DCPO- Women and Child Development Department and members of CHILDLINE participated in a two-day workshop.



SAKSHUM Yuva Shakti:


A campaign consisting of Outreach, Social Media Communication and Competitions conducted by Youth groups.



To eliminate the child marriages in Maharashtra, the Women and Child Development Department, UNICEF and SBC3 had organized an online orientation program for 12 youth volunteers of Neharu Yuva Kendra, Hingoli Maharashtra on 26th Oct 2021. Ms. Sarswati Korade, Hon'ble District Child Protection officer, Mr. Ashish Pant, District Youth Coordinator, NYK, Hingoli and Ms. Meenakumari Yadav, Project Head Ending child marriage program, were present for the program. Ms. Pooja Yadav, Head of Program state, SBC3 facilitated the orientation program and provided information about the SAKSHUM Yuva Shakti- youth-led program for Ending child marriages in Maharashtra.

Parbhani District has a 48% high child marriage prevalence compared to the state of Therefore, the Centre for Social and Behaviour Change Maharashtra. Communication is implementing the Ending Child Marriage Program in collaboration with UNICEF and the Women and Child Development Department of Maharashtra in consultation with the District Collector of Parbhani. As part of program implementation, we conducted online Orientation of SAKSHUM Yuva Shakti with 43 participants from Students of Social Work College of Parbhani on 30th October 2021. Hon. Kailash Tidke, District Women and Child Development Officer and Hon. Archana Meshram, District Child Protection Officer shared the challenges of elimination of child marriages and efforts made by the District Women and Child Development Department of State and by District Administration. Hon. Sarang Salavi, Principal of Ageel Sir College of Social Work also guided students in understanding the different aspects of child marriage and at-risk groups of society like people from poor economic strata, single parent's girl child, Sex workers' girl children. During the session, students asked questions regarding campaign materials, suggested the strategies for creating awareness on child marriage, and agreed to participate in the campaign of SAKSHUM Yuva Shakti.

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
